

From its formation (25 August 2022) through 31 December 2023, Aspen Fly Right received \$135,444 of donations. Expenditures totaled \$112,818, of which 91% paid for our public information efforts—website, newspaper advertisements, outreach consultant, and minor outreach activities.
